


Ddong Hangul Business Plan



We teach Hangul by combining consonants and vowels, the principle behind the creation of Hangul.

"Even a fool can learn it in a week, and a smart person in just half a day."
-훈민정음-

That's right. Anyone can easily read and write Hagul by learning vowels & consonants and understanding the principles of the letters.



In Ddong Hangul, you start by learning the phonetic values of vowels and consonants

Hangul consists of 10 vowels and 14 consonants.

After learning the phonetic values of vowels and consonants,

you can read them using the principles of combination.

The combination of $\neg(\neg) + \vdash(\neg)$ is read as '7\'

'가~기' '하~히 ' could be read the same way.

The consonant letter can also be read as '각' by adding ㄱ(윽) to 가.

Children can learn Hangul easily and quickly through the scientific combination principles of Hangul created by King Sejong. Learning and having fun at the same time through a world of characters based on poop O

In the land of Ddong Hangul Kingdom, there lived all sorts of poops. One day, the evil Ddong Goblin, who dreamed of turning the kingdon into a place where no one could read, kidnapped Princess Golden Ddong. 




